Mock Assessments

Well done to the 3rd Years on the completion of their mocks in February.

The mocks were an opportunity for the 3rd Years to assess their strengths and identify areas for improvement. Naturally, as part of the mock experience students will be happy with some results & perhaps, more disappointed with others. What is important & essential now is that study plans are put in place to learn from these assessments to ensure progress in the lead up to June.

Teachers & students have been reviewing the papers & identifying areas for improvement. During tutor time, the 3rd Years have been filling out a mock review form where they assessed their strengths, areas for improvement & practical strategies to implement between now and June.

From the feedback from the 3rd Year survey, the areas they identified for improvement for themselves in the exams included:

- Time management
- Greater development of answers in longer questions
- Answering the question asked
- Practising more exam papers
- Spreading study more evenly
- Studying sooner!

It is very positive that the girls can pin point their own areas to work on. This feedback will also be shared with their teachers for their planning with them.

In order to support the 3rd Years with their study plans, Ms. O'Malley & Mr. Drury in our Guidance Department have organised small group review meetings with the students that will continue after Easter. In these meetings, their mock results will be discussed and they will be given advice & encouragement with their study preparation.
