

- The <u>Principal/Deputy</u> may be contacted if there is a very serious or urgent issue.
- Illness, medical/dental apt.s etc. may be communicated through the school office if a note is not possible

# Procedures for arriving & leaving school

- Students must attend tutor time 8.50 class punctually
- If a student arrives late to school she must sign in at reception
- If a student needs to leave school early the note must be sent early in the day to the school through the App
- If a student is unwell during the day, she can make her way to reception (with her teacher's permission). Parents will be contacted by the office staff. A student should not contact home using her mobile phone!
- If you wish to collect your daughter from school and if you have not completed a note, please phone the school office.
- On the first day of illness contact the school to avoid the text message
- Mobile Phones are not permitted in school. Students will always be accommodated should they need to contact their parents.

- Please monitor homework


