Dear TY Parents/Guardians

Re: 'We Will Rock You' Musical 2020 - Ticket Refund

As we approach the anniversary that saw the Covid 19 pandemic arrive to our shores and change how we live our lives I hope that you and your family are keeping well.

When the school doors closed on the 12th of March 2020 one of the great disappointments faced by our 2019-20 Transition Year students was the cancellation of their musical "We Will Rock You".

This was particularly hard for the cast as they had been rehearsing since January and for the crew as they had been preparing the costumes, make-up, lighting, music and show programmes only to be shut down just over two weeks shy of Opening Night.

TY students from both LCF and CBC, their parents, and staff members were left humming the wonderful Queen songs that make up the We Will Rock You musical at home while doing their homework or completing house chores instead of dancing and singing on the CBC stage.

Before the school closed on the 12th of March 2020 a small number of tickets were sold to an eager audience. Thank you for your patience over the past number of months as we tried to find a fair and an efficient system to refund the cost of tickets purchased. This has proven to be difficult.

In order to receive a refund, students and/or parents are being asked to return the musical tickets bought or provide proof of purchase by the 30th of April 2021.

To keep within the Covid 19 guideline restrictions we would ask that all tickets be returned to our post box in Reception in a clearly marked envelope addressed to our Bursar, Naoisha Maher, with your name and bank details by the 30th of April 2021. Naoisha will then
