Dear Parents/Guardians,

A number of 6<sup>th</sup> Year students have requested supervised study on Saturdays for the final school term. It is proposed to provide this on the following four Saturdays:

**30<sup>th</sup> April**

**7<sup>th</sup> May**

**14<sup>th</sup> May**

**21<sup>st</sup> May**

Study will begin at **10.00 am** sharp and finish at **2.30 pm**. There will be a **half hour break** from 12.00 – 12.30 pm. To ensure strict adherence to the timetable, thereby maximising study time, students will **not be allowed to leave the study area during the day** except to use the bathroom.

Students who participate must agree to abide by the rules:

- Students must study alone, in strict silence and use only their own materials and books.
- No food may be eaten outside of the half hour lunch break.
- The use of headphones/earphones during study time is strictly prohibited.
- The use of a laptop computer for schoolwork may be allowed, as long as it does not distract other students from their work.
- Students may not access any part of the school other than the designated study area.
- Students must attend for the full duration from 10.00am – 2.30pm. In the event of a student's absence, the parent/guardian will be notified by text message.

The proposed supervised study will only take place if enough students sign up. An administration fee of **€30** will apply, whether or not your daughter can attend on all four Saturdays.

If you would like your daughter to attend Saturday study, please complete the consent form and make payment via the school app **by Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> April**. If there is not enough interest, refunds will be issued in the days following Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April.
