Dear Parent/Guardian,

The History Department is organising a 3rd Year trip to Trim Castle and the Irish Military War Museum on Thursday, 10th March. We will be leaving the school at 8.50am and returning to the school at 4.00pm approximately.

Trim Castle is the largest Anglo-Norman fortification in Ireland. The guided tour will help students revise a topic they have not studied since 1st year. In addition to this, the visit to the Irish Military War Museum will help students to better understand the wars and conflicts of the 20th century, which they have studied this year, and give each student the chance to ride in a tank!


The total cost of the trip is € 32 per student, which includes the cost of the bus. This is payable via the school app. Please make payment and complete the online consent form by Friday 4th March.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and outdoor clothing, in case of bad weather. It is very mucky getting in and out of the tank, so students must also wear appropriate shoes.

The school's code of behaviour applies throughout the duration of the trip.

We hope that the trip will be an enjoyable and educational day for 3rd Year students.
